3035.) AUCKLAND CITY LICENSED HOTEL ASSISTANTS.—AGREE-MENT.*

This industrial agreement, made in pursuance of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908, and its amendments, this 7th day of April, 1914, between the Auckland City Licensed Hotel Assistants' Industrial Union of Workers, an industrial union duly registered under the said Act (hereinafter called "the union"), of the one part, and the Auckland Licensed Victuallers' Association Industrial Union of Employers of the other part (hereinafter called "the employers"), witnesseth as follows:—

1. In pursuance of section 29 of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908, the industrial agreement entered into between the Auckland City Licensed Hotel Assistants' Industrial Union of Workers and the Auckland Licensed Victuallers' Association Industrial Union of Employers on the 7th day of March, 1914,

is hereby cancelled by mutual consent.

2. The aforementioned parties hereby agree that the Court of Arbitration be requested to make an award in the terms of the settlement arrived at by the parties on the 3rd April, 1914.
