• (3089.) ROTORUA TOURIST, ACCOMMODATION, AND BOARDING-HOUSE WORKERS.—AMENDMENT OF AWARD.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Northern Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908, and its amendments; and in the matter of an award dated the 25th day of October, 1912, made in an industrial dispute between the Auckland Hotel and Restaurant Employees' (Rotorua Branch) Industrial Union of Workers and J. F. Falloona and other employers (Book of Awards, Vol. xiii, p. 888).

Thursday, the 30th day of April, 1914.

UPON reading the application of the above-named union filed herein, and upon reading the consent filed herein by the employers to the said award, this Court doth order that the following clause be inserted in the said award after clause 1 thereof:—

1. (a.) *Casual Labour*.—Male cook, 10s. per day, 2s. per hour; woman cook, 7s. 6d. per day, 1s. 6d. per hour; other kitchen hands, 6s. 6d. per day, 1s. per hour; porter, 5s. 6d. per day, 1s. per hour; laundress, 5s. per day, 1s. per hour; housemaids, waitresses, housemaid-waitresses, pantrymaids, 4s. 6d. per day, 1s. per hour.
