(3096.) INANGAHUA GOLD-MINERS.—AMENDMENT OF AWARD.

IN the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Westland Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908, and its amendments; and in the matter of an award dated the 14th day of November, 1913, and made in an industrial dispute between the Progress Mines of New Zealand (Limited) and others and the Inangahua Miners' Industrial Union of Workers (Book of Awards, Vol. xiv, p. 769).
