

(4175.) WELLINGTON DISTRICT FLAX-MILLS EMPLOYEES.—ORDER  
AMENDING AWARD.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Wellington Industrial District. — In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908, and its amendments; and in the matter of an award dated the 26th day of August, 1915, made in an industrial dispute between the Manawatu Flax-mill Employees' Industrial Union of Workers and the Manawatu Flax-mills Employers' Association and others.

Thursday, the 16th day of September, 1915.

IN pursuance of section 92, subsection (1) (a), of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908, and for the purpose of remedying a defect in the said award, this Court doth order that the said award be and the same is hereby amended by inserting in clause 2 of the said award, after the word "eight," the words "and three-quarters."

This order shall take effect as from the 13th day of September, 1915.
