

(4188.) NAPIER BOROUGH COUNCIL GENERAL LABOURERS AND QUARRY-WORKERS.—SUPPLEMENTARY AGREEMENT.

THIS industrial agreement, made in pursuance of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908, this 25th day of September, 1915, between the Wellington General Labourers' Industrial Union of Workers, a duly registered industrial union having its registered office in the City of Wellington, and having a duly registered branch office at Napier, in the Provincial District of Hawke's Bay (hereinafter called "the union"), of the one part, and the Mayor, Councillors, and Burgesses of the Borough of Napier (hereinafter called "the Corporation") of the other part, whereby it is mutually agreed as follows:—

The industrial agreement made between the parties hereto and bearing date the 20th day of May, 1908, and hereinafter referred to as "the old agreement," is hereby varied in the manner following, that is to say,—

*Holidays.*—Owing to the Napier Corporation being the only employer in Napier recognizing Dominion Day as a holiday for the general labourers, the said Corporation and the Wellington General Labourers' Union of Workers of the Napier Branch have agreed to substitute Show Day for Dominion Day.
