(4083.) NORTHERN DISTRICT (EXCEPT GISBORNE DISTRICT) BREWERIES', MALT-HOUSES', AND BOTTLING-HOUSES' EMPLOYEES.—AMENDMENT OF AWARD.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Northern Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908, and its amendments; and in the matter of an award dated the 9th day of September, 1913, made in an industrial dispute between the Auckland Brewers, Wine and Spirit Merchants, and Aerated-water Employees' Industrial Union of Workers and Campbell and Ehrenfried and others.

Wednesday, the 2nd day of June, 1915.

Upon reading the application of the above-named union filed herein on the 10th day of March, 1915, and upon hearing the duly appointed representative of the said union of workers and the duly appointed representative of the employers parties to the said award, and with the consent of the said employers, this Court doth order that the said award be and the same is hereby amended as from the date hereof as follows:—

By deleting from clause 16 (b) of the said award the word "join," and substituting in lieu thereof the words "become and remain a member."

By deleting from the said award the clause numbered 17 (a).
