

(4096.) WELLINGTON ELECTRICAL WORKERS.—AMENDMENT
OF AWARD.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Wellington Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908, and its amendments; and in the matter of an award dated the 15th day of May, 1915, made in an industrial dispute between the Wellington Electrical Workers' Industrial Union of Workers and H. G. Anderson and Co. and others.

Tuesday, the 6th day of July, 1915.

FOR the purpose of remedying a defect in the said award, and of giving effect to the agreement of the parties as embodied in the recommendation of the Council of Conciliation in respect of the said dispute, this Court doth order that the said award be and the same is hereby amended by inserting in clause 2 (b) thereof, after the word "batteries," the words "or in a freezing-chamber while freezing operations are substantially being carried on."
