

(4374.) NORTHERN, WELLINGTON, CANTERBURY, AND OTAGO AND SOUTHLAND FACTORY TAILORESSES, MACHINISTS, CUTTERS, AND PRESSERS. — ADDING PARTIES TO AWARD (IN OTAGO) AND SPECIAL PROVISIONS.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Otago and Southland Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908, and its amendments; and in the matter of an award dated the 4th day of May, 1916, made in an industrial dispute between the New Zealand Wholesale Clothing-manufacturers' Industrial Association of Employers and the New Zealand Federated Tailoresses and other Clothing Trade Employees' Industrial Association of Workers..

(a.) They shall pay to the workers employed by them in making for the wholesale trade male attire (except hats and underclothing), ladies' costumes and overcoats, not less than the wages mentioned in clauses 4 and 7 of the said award for a week of forty-five hours.

(b.) They are exempted from the other provisions of the said award.
