

TARANAKI INDUSTRIAL DISTRICT.

(4240.) TARANAKI PAINTERS AND DECORATORS.—AMENDMENT OF AWARD.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Taranaki Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908, and its amendments; and in the matter of an award dated the 3rd day of August, 1915, made in an industrial dispute between the Taranaki Painters and Decorators' Industrial Union of Workers and W. Bateman and other employers therein named.

Thursday, the 30th day of March, 1916.

UPON reading the application of the above-named union filed herein on the 19th day of January, 1916, and upon hearing the duly appointed representative of the said union, and there being no appearance on behalf of the said employers and no objection filed on their behalf, this Court doth order—

1. Clause 2 of the said award shall be and the same is hereby deleted, and in lieu thereof the following clause shall be substituted:—

“ 2. All journeymen painters, paperhangers, glaziers, grainers, signwriters, decorators, and all other journeymen working at any branch of the trade, except those hereinafter provided, shall be paid not less than 1s. 4½d. per hour.”

2. This order shall come into force on the 10th day of April, 1916.
