

(4426.) AUCKLAND GENERAL LABOURERS (*RE* COAL, LIME, SAND,
AND CEMENT WORKERS).—ADDING PARTIES TO AWARD.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Northern Industrial District. — In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908, and its amendments; and in the matter of an award dated the 3rd day of April, 1916, made in an industrial dispute between the Auckland General Labourers' (Coal, Lime, Sand, and Cement Workers' Section) Industrial Union of Workers and J. Adams and others.

Provided that so far as the Auckland Gas Company (Limited) is concerned the award shall apply only to such workers in their employ as are engaged in the handling of coke for sale either wholesale or retail.

This order shall take effect as from the 18th day of September, 1916.
