

(4447.) CHRISTCHURCH ENGINEERS.—ORDER AMENDING AWARDS
ON AMALGAMATION OF UNIONS.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Canterbury Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908, and its amendments; and in the matter of an award dated the 30th day of June, 1915, made in an industrial dispute between the Canterbury Metal-workers' Assistants' Industrial Union of Workers and J. Anderson and Sons and others (Book of Awards, Vol. xvi, p. 333); and in the matter of an award dated the 5th day of May, 1915, made in an industrial dispute between the Christchurch Rangemakers' Industrial Union of Workers and T. Atkinson and others (Book of Awards, Vol. xvi, p. 64); and in the matter of an award dated the 30th day of June, 1915, made in an industrial dispute between the Christchurch Branch of the Amalgamated Society of Engineers Industrial Union of Workers and J. Anderson and Sons and others (Book of Awards, Vol. xvi, p. 322), and its amendments; and in the matter of an award dated the 8th day of December, 1911, made in an industrial dispute between the Canterbury Tinsmiths and Sheet-metal Workers' Industrial Union of Workers and F. L. Adams and others (Book of Awards, Vol. xii, p. 892); and in the matter of an award dated the 20th day of June, 1913, made in an industrial dispute between the Canterbury Electrical Workers' Industrial Union of Workers and Brown Bros. and others (Book of Awards, Vol. xiv, p. 438), and its amendments.

UPON reading the application filed herein on the 17th day of August, 1916, and upon hearing the duly appointed representative of the applicants, and it appearing that the unions above named are desirous to amalgamate so as to form one union, and that the said unions have taken steps to carry out such desire by registering a new industrial union under the name of "The Christchurch Branch of the Amalgamated Society of Engineers, including Brass-finishers, Range-workers, Metal-workers' Assistants, Electrical Workers, Tinsmiths, and Sheet-metal Workers and their Assistants' Industrial Union of Workers," now, therefore, by virtue of section 20 of the said Act, this Court doth order that the said awards be and the same are hereby amended by substituting the name of the union last mentioned as a party to the said awards in lieu of the unions above named respectively.
