

(4467.) NORTHERN DISTRICT SADDLERS AND HARNESS AND BAG  
MAKERS.—AMENDMENT OF AWARD.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Northern Industrial District. — In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908, and its amendments; and in the matter of an award dated the 8th day of August, 1916, made in an industrial dispute between the Auckland Saddlers, Harness-makers, Collarmakers, Bagmakers, and Bridle-cutters' Society Industrial Union of Workers and F. J. Allely and others.

Tuesday, the 8th day of August, 1916.

By virtue of section 92, subsection (1) (a), of the said Act, and for the purpose of remedying a clerical error appearing in the recommendations of the Conciliation Council accepted by the parties and repeated in the said award, this Court doth order that the said award be and the same is hereby amended as from the date hereof by striking out the word "journeymen" from clause 3, sub-clause (c), of the said award, and substituting in lieu thereof the word "journeywomen."
