

(4497.) WELLINGTON WHOLESALE MERCHANTS' STOREMEN AND PACKERS.—AMENDMENT OF AWARD.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Wellington Industrial District. — In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908, and its amendments; and in the matter of an award dated the 15th day of May, 1916, made in an industrial dispute between the Wellington United Storemen and Packers' Industrial Union of Workers and Abbott, Oram, and Co. and others.

Monday, the 6th day of November, 1916.

UPON reading the application for an amendment of this award filed on the 10th day of October, 1916, and after hearing Mr. Monteith on behalf of the union, and by consent of Mr. Grenfell on behalf of the employers, this Court doth order that the said award be amended and it is hereby amended by adding to clause 1 of the said award the following provision:—

“(c.) An ordinary day's work shall not exceed nine hours, and (notwithstanding anything hereinafter contained) overtime shall be paid for any time worked in excess of nine hours on any one day.”

This order shall take effect from the 20th day of November, 1916.
