

(4506.) AUCKLAND FISH CURERS AND SMOKERS.—AMENDMENT  
OF AWARD.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Northern Industrial District. — In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908, and its amendments; and in the matter of an award dated the 10th day of August, 1916, made in an industrial dispute between the Auckland Fish Trade Employees' Industrial Union of Workers and J. Andrews and others.

Monday, the 4th day of December, 1916.

UPON reading the application filed herein on behalf of the union above named on the 18th day of September, 1916, and upon hearing the duly appointed representative of the said union, and it appearing that the said union in the proceedings for the award above mentioned has therein wrongly described itself, now therefore this Court doth order, by virtue of section 92, subsection 1 (a), of the said Act, that the title "The Auckland Fish Trade Employees' (other than Fishermen) Industrial Union of Workers" be and the same is hereby substituted for "The Auckland Fish Trade Employees' Industrial Union of Workers" wherever the same appears in the said award.
