

(4515.) DUNEDIN GROCERS' ASSISTANTS AND DRIVERS.—AMENDMENT OF AWARD.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Otago and Southland Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908, and its amendments; and in the matter of an award dated the 25th day of May, 1916, made in an industrial dispute between the Otago Grocers' Assistants' Industrial Union of Workers and W. Aitken and others.

Friday, the 24th day of November, 1916.

By virtue of section 92, subsection (1) (a), of the said Act, and for the purpose of remedying a defect in the said award and of giving fuller effect to the agreement of the parties to the said award, this Court doth order that the said award be and the same is hereby amended by inserting after clause 5 of the said award the following subclause:—

“(g.) The proportion of under-rate workers shall not exceed one to every three fully-paid journeymen or fraction of three after the first three.”
