

(4517.) NORTHERN DISTRICT (EXCEPT GISBORNE JUDICIAL DISTRICT) PLASTERERS.—ADDING PARTY TO AWARD.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Northern Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908, and its amendments; and in the matter of an award dated the 14th day of August, 1916, made in an industrial dispute between the Auckland Operative Plasterers' Industrial Union of Workers and P. Allen and others.

UPON reading the application of the above-named union filed herein on the 10th day of November, 1916, and upon hearing the duly appointed representative of the said union and Mr. O. Lorrigan, the person named in the said application, this Court doth order that the said O. Lorrigan and one W. E. Hutchison in respect of an accommodation-house now in course of construction at East Tamaki.
