(4525.) NORTHERN DISTRICT (EXCEPT GISBORNE JUDICIAL DISTRICT) PAINTERS AND DECORATORS.—AMENDMENT OF AWARD.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Northern Industrial District. — In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908, and its amendments; and in the matter of an award dated the 5th day of September, 1916, made in an industrial dispute between the Auckland Painters' Industrial Union of Workers and Adams Bros. and others.

Monday, the 4th day of December, 1916.

Upon reading the application filed herein on the 25th day of November, 1916, by the Auckland Guild of Master Painters, and upon hearing the duly appointed representatives of the said Guild and of the said union, and it appearing that the recommendations of the Conciliation Council in the said dispute were incomplete, now therefore, by virtue of section 92, subsection (1) (a), of the said Act, this Court doth order that the said award be and the same is hereby amended by inserting in the said award after clause 12 thereof the following words: "except dusters and paperhangers' laying-on brushes."
