

**(4286.) OTAGO AND SOUTHLAND SHEARING-SHED HANDS.—ORDER  
EXTENDING MARLBOROUGH SHEARING-SHED HANDS' AWARD  
TO THE OTAGO AND SOUTHLAND INDUSTRIAL DISTRICT.**

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Otago and Southland Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908, and its amendments; and in the matter of an award dated the 16th day of August, 1915, made in an industrial dispute between the Marlborough Shearers and Wool-shed Employees' Industrial Union of Workers and the Marlborough Sheepowners' Industrial Union of Employers.
