(4313.) POVERTY BAY SHEARING-SHED HANDS.—ORDER EXTENDING MARLBOROUGH SHEARING-SHED HANDS' AWARD TO THE NORTHERN INDUSTRIAL DISTRICT (POVERTY BAY).

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Northern Industrial District. — In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908, and its amendments; and in the matter of an award dated the 16th day of August, 1915, made in an industrial dispute between the Marlborough Shearers and Woolshed Employees' Industrial Union of Workers and the Marlborough Sheepowners' Industrial Union of Employers.
