## (4706. NORTH CANTERBURY CARPENTERS AND JOINERS.—AMENDMENT OF AWARD.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Canterbury Industrial District. — In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908, and its amendments; and in the matter of an award dated the 28th day of May, 1917, made in an industrial dispute between the Amalgamated Society of Carpenters and Joiners' (Christchurch and Sydenham Branches) Industrial Union of Workers and the Canterbury Builders and Contractors' Association Industrial Union of Employers and others.

Upon reading the application of the above-named union of workers and the consent of the above-named union of employers thereto attached, and filed herein on the 28th day of June, 1917, and by virtue of section 92, subsection (1) (a), of the said Act, this Court doth order that the said award be and the same is hereby amended as follows, that is to say: By inserting in clause 5 (e) thereof, after the words "Labour Day," the words "Show Day."
