

(4784.) NORTHERN, WELLINGTON, CANTERBURY, AND OTAGO AND SOUTHLAND FACTORY TAILORESSES, MACHINISTS, CUTTERS AND PRESSERS.—AMENDMENT OF AWARD.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Northern, Wellington, Canterbury, and Otago and Southland Industrial Districts.— In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908, and its amendments; and in the matter of an award dated the 4th day of May, 1916, made in an industrial dispute between the New Zealand Wholesale Clothing Manufacturers' Industrial Association of Employers and the New Zealand Federated Tailoresses and other Clothing Trade Employees' Industrial Association of Workers.

Friday, the 9th day of November, 1917.

UPON reading the application for an increase of war bonus filed herein on the 3rd day of October, 1917, by the association of workers above named, and upon hearing the duly appointed representatives of the said association of workers and of the association of employers above named, this Court doth order that the said award (Book of Awards, Vol. xvii, p. 650) be and the same is hereby amended as follows: By deleting from clause 2 (a) of the said award the words "7½ per cent.," and substituting in lieu thereof the words "10 per cent."

And this Court doth further order that this order shall take effect as from the 19th day of November, 1917.
