(4589.) WELLINGTON DISTRICT IRON AND BRASS MOULDERS.— AMENDMENT OF AWARD.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Wellington Industrial District.— In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908, and its amendments; and in the matter of an award dated the 6th day of December, 1916, made in an industrial dispute between the Wellington Iron and Brass Moulders' Industrial Union of Workers and Walter Andrews and others.
