

CANTERBURY INDUSTRIAL DISTRICT.

(4978.) CANTERBURY MOTOR MECHANICS.—AMENDMENT OF AWARD.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Canterbury Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908, and its amendments; and in the matter of an award dated the 19th day of July, 1918, made in an industrial dispute between the Christchurch Branch of the Amalgamated Society of Engineers' (including Brass-finishers, Range-workers, Metal-workers' Assistants, Electrical Workers, Tinsmiths and Sheet-metal Workers, and Cycle-workers) Industrial Union of Workers and Adams Limited and others.

Wednesday, the 7th day of August, 1918.

By virtue of section 92, subsection (1) (a), of the said Act, and for the purpose of remedying a defect in the said award, this Court doth order that the said award be and the same is hereby amended by deleting from clause 2 thereof the words "5 p.m." where they first appear, and by substituting in lieu thereof the words "6 p.m."

This order shall take effect as from the 5th day of August, 1918.
