

(4986.) AUCKLAND TRAWLER EMPLOYEES.—AMENDMENT OF
AWARD.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Northern Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908, and its amendments; and in the matter of an award dated the 6th day of December, 1917, made in an industrial dispute between the Auckland Trawler Employees' Industrial Union of Workers and the Auckland City Council and another.

Saturday, the 7th day of September, 1918.

UPON reading the application of the above-named union filed herein on the 9th day of July, 1918, and upon hearing the duly appointed representatives of the said union and of the employers respectively, and with the consent of the Auckland City Council and of A. Sandford (Limited), the employers named in the said award, this Court doth order that the said award be and the same is hereby amended by inserting in clause 6 thereof, after the words " 5 p.m.," the words " until 7 a.m."
