(5053.) SOUTHLAND CARPENTERS AND JOINERS. — ORDER INCREASING WAR BONUS.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Otago and Southland Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908, and its amendments; and in the matter of an award dated the 28th day of May, 1917, made in an industrial dispute between the Invercargill Branch of the Amalgamated Society of Carpenters and Joiners' Industrial Union of Workers and the Southland Builders and Contractors' Industrial Union of Employers and others.

Monday, the 9th day of December, 1918.

By virtue of the power reserved by subclause (d) of clause 2 of the said award, this Court of its own motion doth order that the war bonus of 2d. per hour provided by subclause (c) of the said clause be increased by 1d. per hour; and the said award is hereby amended by striking out the words "2d." where they occur in subclause (c) of clause 2, and by inserting in lieu thereof the words "3d."

This order shall come into force and shall take effect from the 6th day of January, 1919. T. W. STRINGER, Judge.
