

WELLINGTON INDUSTRIAL DISTRICT.

(5055.) WELLINGTON (TWENTY-FIVE-MILE RADIUS) WHOLESALE MERCHANTS' STOREMEN AND PACKERS. — AMENDMENT OF AWARD.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Wellington Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908, and its amendments; and in the matter of an award dated the 19th day of October, 1918, made in an industrial dispute between the Wellington United Storemen's Industrial Union of Workers and Abbott, Oram, and Co. (Limited) and others.

Friday, the 22nd day of November, 1918.

By virtue of section 92, subsection (1) (a), of the said Act, and for the purpose of giving effect to the agreement of the parties to the said award, this Court doth order that the said award be and the same is hereby amended by adding to clause 2 thereof, after subclause (b), the following subclause:—

“(c.) Notice shall be given the previous day to an employee who is required to work overtime, or in lieu thereof tea-money shall be paid.”

This order shall take effect as from the 4th day of November, 1918.
