(5065.) NORTH CANTERBURY CARPENTERS AND JOINERS.—ORDER INCREASING WAR BONUS.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Canterbury Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908, and its amendments; and in the matter of an award dated the 28th day of May, 1917, made in an industrial dispute between the Amalgamated Society of Carpenters and Joiners' (Christchurch and Sydenham Branches) Industrial Union of Workers and the Canterbury Builders and Contractors' Association Industrial Union of Employers and others.

Thursday, the 28th day of November, 1918.

UPON reading the application of the above-named industrial union of workers filed herein on the 21st day of October, 1918, and upon hearing the duly appointed representatives of the said industrial union of workers and of the employers respectively, and by virtue of the power reserved by clause 2, subclause (d), of the said award, this Court doth order that the war bonus of 2d. per hour provided by clause 2, subclause (c), of the said award be increased by 1d. per hour; and the said award is hereby amended by deleting the words "2d." where they occur in clause 2, subclause (c), of the said award, and by substituting in lieu thereof the words "3d."

The order shall come into force and shall take effect from the 6th day of December, 1918.
