

(4871.) WELLINGTON (TWENTY-FIVE-MILE RADIUS) PRIVATE-HOTEL, OYSTER-SALOON, RESTAURANT, LUNCHEON-ROOM, TEA-ROOM, AND REFRESHMENT-ROOM WORKERS.—AMENDMENT OF AWARD.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Wellington Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908, and its amendments; and in the matter of an award dated the 13th day of November, 1917, made in an industrial dispute between the Wellington District Hotel, Club, and Restaurant Workers' Industrial Union of Workers and Mrs. T. Black and others.

Monday, the 11th day of March, 1918.

UPON reading the application of the above-named union filed herein on the 19th day of February, 1918, and upon hearing the duly appointed representatives of the said union and of the employers parties to the said award, and with the consent of the said employers, this Court doth order that the said award be and ~~the~~ same is hereby amended as follows: By striking out the word "now" where the same occurs in clause 9 (a) of the said award—namely, "Workers covered by Part II of this award who are engaged in establishments which are now closed for business on Sundays," &c.
