

(5083.) WANGANUI AND RANGITIKEI CARPENTERS AND JOINERS.—  
ADDING PARTIES TO AWARD.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Wellington Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908, and its amendments; and in the matter of an award dated the 23rd day of July, 1917, made in an industrial dispute between the Amalgamated Society of Carpenters and Joiners' (Wanganui Branch) Industrial Union of Workers and James Alderton and others.
