(4880.) NORTH CANTERBURY TINSMITHS AND SHEET-METAL WORKERS.— AMENDMENT OF AWARD.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Canterbury Industrial District. — In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908, and its amendments; and in the matter of an award dated the 12th day of February, 1917, made in an industrial dispute between the Christchurch Branch of the Amalgamated Society of Engineers' (including Brass-finishers, Range-workers, Metal-workers' Assistants, Electrical Workers, Tinsmiths, and Sheet-metal Workers and their Assistants) Industrial Union of Workers and F. L. Adams and others.

Friday, the 22nd day of March, 1918.

Upon reading the application of the above-named union filed herein on the 7th day of March, 1918, and upon hearing the duly appointed representatives of the parties, and by virtue of the power reserved to the Court by clause 5, subclause (c), of the said award, this Court doth order that clause 5, subclause (a), of the said award be and the same is hereby amended as follows: By deleting from the said subclause the words "a war bonus of 3s. per week," and by substituting in lieu thereof the words "a war bonus of 3d. per hour."

This order shall take effect from the 15th day of April, 1918.
