

(4916.) NORTHERN INDUSTRIAL DISTRICT (EXCEPT GISBORNE JUDICIAL DISTRICT) TINSMITHS AND SHEET-METAL WORKERS.—AMENDMENT OF AWARD.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Northern Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908, and its amendments; and in the matter of an award dated the 15th day of December, 1916, made in an industrial dispute between the Auckland Branch of the Amalgamated Society of Engineers' (including Brass-finishers, Tinsmiths, and Sheet-metal Workers) Industrial Union of Workers and Edward Adams and others.

Tuesday, the 7th day of May, 1918.

UPON reading the application of the above-named union filed herein on the 19th day of April, 1918, and upon hearing the duly appointed representatives of the said union and of the employers parties to the said award, and with the consent of the latter, and by virtue of the power reserved to the Court by clause 5, subclause (*d*), of the said award, this Court doth order that the said award be and the same is hereby amended as follows: By deleting from clause 5, subclause (*a*), the words "3s. per week," and by substituting in lieu thereof the words "3d. per hour."

This order shall take effect from the 27th day of May, 1918.
