

(4935.) WELLINGTON INDUSTRIAL DISTRICT TINPLATE AND SHEET-METAL OPERATIVES.—AMENDMENT OF AWARD.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Wellington Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908, and its amendments; and in the matter of an award dated the 8th day of December, 1911, made in an industrial dispute between the Wellington Tinsplate and Sheet-metal Operatives' Industrial Union of Workers and Thomas Ballinger and Co. (Limited) and others.

UPON reading the application filed herein on the 27th day of April, 1918, by the Wellington Branch of the Amalgamated Society

of Engineers' (including Brass-finishers, Coppersmiths, Motor Mechanics, and Tinsplate and Sheet-metal Workers) Industrial Union of Workers for an order under section 20, subsection (2), of the said Act, and upon hearing the duly appointed representative of the applicant union, this Court doth order that the said award be and the same is hereby adjusted in terms of the said subsection by substituting the title of "The Wellington Branch of the Amalgamated Society of Engineers' (including Brass-finishers, Coppersmiths, Motor Mechanics, and Tinsplate and Sheet-metal Workers) Industrial Union of Workers" in lieu of the title "The Wellington Tinsplate and Sheet-metal Operatives' Industrial Union of Workers" appearing in the said award.
