

(4947.) NELSON (THIRTY-MILE RADIUS) BUILDERS', CONTRACTORS',
PLASTERERS', AND GENERAL LABOURERS.—AMENDMENT OF
AWARD.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Nelson Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908, and its amendments; and in the matter of an award dated the 22nd day of March, 1918, made in an industrial dispute between the Nelson General Labourers' Industrial Union of Workers and Henry Baigent and others.

Thursday, the 16th day of May, 1918.

UPON reading the application of the said union and of the Waimea County Council filed herein on the 19th day of April, 1918, and by virtue of section 92, subsection (1) (a), of the said Act, and with the consent of the parties named, this Court doth order that the said award be and the same is hereby amended as follows, by inserting in the said award, after clause 16 (b), the following clause:—

“(c.) So far as the Waimea County Council is concerned this award shall apply to the said Council only in respect of that portion of road known as the Rocks Road, being that portion lying between the Nelson City boundary and the western end of the concrete sea-wall on the Tahuna Road; and this award shall not apply to the said Council in respect of the county roads in the country outside that area.”
