

(5210.) DUNEDIN CANISTER-WORKERS.—ORDER AMENDING
AWARD.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand; Otago and Southland Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908, and its amendments; and in the matter of the War Legislation and Statute Law Amendment Act, 1918; and in the matter of the Dunedin Canister-workers' award dated the 22nd day of April, 1918, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. xix, p. 289.

UPON reading the application of the Dunedin Canister-workers' Industrial Union of Workers filed herein on the 26th day of March,

1919, and after hearing the representative of the said union and the representative of the employers parties to the said award, this Court, having regard to all the relevant considerations and being of opinion that it is just and equitable to amend the said award, doth hereby order that the said award be amended in manner following, that is to say—

1. Clause 3 of the said award shall be deleted, and the following clause substituted therefor :—

“ 3. (a.) The minimum rate of wages for adult canister-workers shall be 1s. 3½d. per hour.

“ (b.) In addition to the above rate of wages there shall be paid to such workers a bonus of 2½d. per hour unless and until the Court otherwise orders.

“ (c.) The above-mentioned bonus shall be excluded from the computation of overtime.”

2. Clause 5 of the said award shall be deleted, and the following clause substituted therefor :—

“ 5. All time worked beyond the hours hereinbefore mentioned shall be considered overtime, and shall be paid for at the rate of time and a half for the first three hours and double time thereafter. Time and a half shall be paid for the following holidays: 1st and 2nd January, Easter Monday, Labour Day, Boxing Day, and the birthday of the reigning Sovereign. Double time shall be paid for work done on Good Friday, Christmas Day, and Sundays. When overtime is worked tea-money (6d.) to be allowed to each worker.”

3. This order shall operate and take effect from the 28th day of April, 1919.
