
(5212.) DUNEDIN AND SUBURBAN FARRIERS.—ORDER AMENDING
AWARD.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Otago and Southland Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908, and its amendments; and in the matter of the War Legislation and Statute Law Amendment Act, 1918; and in the matter of the Dunedin (twenty-five miles radius) Farriers' award dated the 14th day of December, 1917, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. xviii, p. 1207.*

UPON reading the application of the Dunedin and Suburban Farriers' Industrial Union of Workers filed herein on the 15th day of January, 1919, and after hearing the representative of the said union and the representative of the employers parties to the said award, this Court, having regard to all the relevant considerations and being of opinion that it is just and equitable to amend the

said award, doth hereby order that the said award shall be amended in manner following, that is to say—

1. By adding to clause 2 of the said award the following sub-clause:—

“(c.) In addition to the above wages there shall be paid to the said workers a bonus of $2\frac{1}{2}$ d. per hour unless and until the Court shall otherwise order.”

2. Clause 3 of the said award shall be deleted, and the following clause substituted therefor:—

“3. All time worked beyond the hours mentioned in clause 1 hereof in any one day shall be considered to be overtime, and shall be paid for at the rate of time and a half for the first three hours and thereafter double time.”

3. Clause 6 of the said award shall be deleted, and the following clause substituted therefor:—

“6. Piecework shall not be allowed, except shoe-turning, which shall be paid for at 2s. 9d. per dozen for any shoes up to 14 in., and 3s. 3d. per dozen for shoes over 14 in., provided that such piecework shall be done only between the hours of 8 a.m. and 5 p.m.”

4. This order shall operate and take effect from the 5th day of May, 1919.
