

(5236.) NORTHERN INDUSTRIAL DISTRICT ENGINEERS.—ORDER
INCREASING WAR BONUS.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Northern Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908, and its amendments; and in the matter of an award dated the 6th day of December, 1917, made in an industrial dispute between the Auckland Branch of the Amalgamated Society of Engineers' (including Brass-finishers, Tin-smiths, and Sheet-metal Workers) Industrial Union of Workers and Amburys Limited and others.

Wednesday, the 5th day of February, 1919.

UPON reading the application of the above-named union filed herein on the 20th day of January, 1919, and upon hearing the duly appointed representatives of the said union and of the Auckland Ironmasters' Association, and with the consent of the said association and by virtue of the power reserved by clause 5, subclause (e), of the said award, this Court doth order that the said award be and the same is hereby amended as follows, that is to say—

By striking out the words "2d." where they occur in subclause (d) of clause 5 of the said award, and by substituting the words "3d." in lieu thereof.

This order shall take effect as from the 1st day of January, 1919.
