

(5259.) OTAGO AND SOUTHLAND FLOUR-MILLS, ETC., EMPLOYEES.—
ORDER AMENDING AWARD.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Otago and Southland Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908, and its amendments; and in the matter of an award dated the 17th day of April, 1919, made in an industrial dispute between the Otago Flour-mills' Employees' Industrial Union of Workers and the Oamaru Flour-mills' Employees' Industrial Union of Workers and D. L. Christie and others.

By virtue of the provisions of section 92, subsection (1) (a), of the said Act, and for the purpose of remedying a defect in the said award, this Court doth order that the said award shall be and the same is hereby amended in manner following, that is to say—

1. Subclause (e) of clause 3 of the said award shall be deleted, and the following subclause substituted therefor:—

“(e.) Kilnman, 1s. 8d. per hour.”

2. This order shall come into force and shall take effect as from the 23rd day of June, 1919.
