

(5263.) AUCKLAND (TWENTY-FIVE-MILE RADIUS) GROCERS' ASSISTANTS AND DRIVERS.—ORDER AMENDING AWARD.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Northern Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908, and its amendments; and in the matter of the War Legislation and Statute Law Amendment Act, 1918; and in the matter of the Auckland (Twenty-five-mile Radius) Grocers' Assistants and Drivers' award dated the 19th day of February, 1919, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. xx, p. 128.

UPON reading the application of the Auckland Grocers' Assistants' Industrial Union of Workers filed herein on the 20th day of May, 1919, and upon hearing the duly appointed representatives of the said union and of the employers parties to the said award, this Court, having regard to all the relevant considerations and being of opinion that it is just and equitable to amend the said award, doth hereby order that the said award shall be amended in manner following, that is to say—

1. By inserting in clause 2 of the said award, after subclause (b) thereof, the following additional subclause:—

“(b.) (1.) In addition to the minimum rates prescribed in the foregoing subclauses there shall be paid to the said workers a bonus of $7\frac{1}{2}$ per cent. upon the said rates unless and until the Court shall otherwise order.”

2. This order shall operate and take effect as from the 30th day of June, 1919.
