(5298.) NORTHERN DISTRICT GUM-WORKERS.—ORDER AMENDING AWARD.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Northern Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908, and its amendments; and in the matter of the War Legislation and Statute Law Amendment Act, 1918; and in the matter of the Northern District Gum-workers' award dated the 5th day of September, 1918, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. xix, p. 741.

Upon reading the application of the Auckland Gum-workers' Industrial Union of Workers filed herein on the 14th day of May, 1919, and upon hearing the duly appointed representatives of the said union and of the employers parties to the said award, this Court, having regard to all the relevant considerations and being of opinion that it is just and equitable to amend the said award, doth hereby order that the said award shall be amended in manner following, that is to say—

1. By inserting in the said award, after clause 2, subclause (c),

thereof, the following additional provision:

"((\dot{a})) In addition to the minimum rates above prescribed there shall be paid to the workers above mentioned a bonus of $2\frac{1}{2}$ d. per hour unless and until the Court shall otherwise order."

2. This order shall operate and take effect from the 21st day of

July, 1919.
