

(5304.) AUCKLAND BIOGRAPH OPERATORS.—ORDER STRIKING OUT PARTIES TO AWARD.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Northern Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908, and its amendments; and in the matter of an award dated the 17th day of June, 1919, made in an industrial dispute between the Auckland Biograph Operators' Industrial Union of Workers and G. Alexander and others.
