

(5314.) WELLINGTON (100-MILES RADIUS) PLASTERERS.—ORDER
AMENDING AWARD.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Wellington Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908, and its amendments; and in the matter of the War Legislation and Statute Law Amendment Act, 1918; and in the matter of the Wellington (100-miles Radius) Plasterers' award dated the 14th day of March, 1918, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. xix, p. 73.

UPON reading the application of the Wellington Plasterers' Industrial Union of Workers filed herein on the 13th day of May, 1919, and upon hearing the duly appointed representatives of the said union and of the employers parties to the said award, this Court, having regard to all the relevant considerations and being of opinion that it is just and equitable to amend the said award, doth hereby order that the said award shall be amended in manner following, that is to say—

1. Clause 4 of the said award shall be deleted, and the following provisions substituted therefor:—

“4. (a.) All journeymen plasterers shall be paid at the rate of not less than 1s. 9d. per hour.

“ (b.) In addition to the minimum rate above prescribed there shall be paid to the said journeymen a bonus of 2½d. per hour unless and until the Court shall otherwise order.”

2. Subclause (k) of clause 6 of the said award shall be deleted, and the following provisions substituted therefor:—

“ (k.) In addition to the minimum rates prescribed in subclause (b) of this clause there shall be paid to all apprentices coming within the scope of this award a bonus of 20 per cent. upon the said rates unless and until the Court shall otherwise order.”

3. This order shall operate and take effect from the 28th day of July, 1919.
