## (5337.) A U C K L A N D FIRE BRIGADES' EMPLOYEES.—SUPPLE-MENTARY AGREEMENT WITH THE AUCKLAND FIRE BOARD, UNDER THE LABOUR DISPUTES INVESTIGATION ACT, 1913.

In the matter of an industrial agreement between the Auckland Fire Brigade Employees' Industrial Union of Workers and the Auckland Fire Board dated the 2nd day of July, 1919.

It is hereby agreed between the aforesaid parties that the said agreement shall be amended as follows, that is to say—

Clause 2 (c) shall be struck out, and the following inserted in lieu thereof: "One short leave of six hours every sixth day, such leave to commence at 12 noon and at 6 p.m. alternately."
