(5115.) AUCKLAND (TEN-MILE RADIUS) LOCAL BODIES' LABOURERS. ORDER INCREASING WAR BONUS.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Northern Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908, and its amendments; and in the matter of an award made between the Auckland and Suburban Local Bodies' Labourers' Industrial Union of Workers and the various local bodies mentioned in the said award, recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. xviii, p. 1014.

Upon reading the application of the said union filed herein on the 31st day of January, 1919, and after hearing the representative of the said union and the representatives of the said local bodies, this Court, in pursuance of the power in that behalf contained in clause 2, subclause (f), of the said award, doth hereby order that the war bonus of $17\frac{1}{2}$ per cent. provided by subclause (e) of said clause 2 shall be and it is hereby increased to $22\frac{1}{2}$ per cent. as from the 31st day of March, 1919.
