

(5346.) DUNEDIN TRAMWAY EMPLOYEES.—SUPPLEMENTARY AGREEMENT WITH DUNEDIN CITY CORPORATION, UNDER THE LABOUR DISPUTES INVESTIGATION ACT, 1913.

In the matter of the Labour Disputes Investigation Act, 1913; and in the matter of an agreement entered into on the 23rd day of January, 1919, between the Corporation of the Mayor, Councillors, and Citizens of the City of Dunedin (hereinafter called "the employer") of the one part, and the Otago Tramways Union of Workers (hereinafter called "the union") of the other part.

WHEREAS it is provided in section 8 (2) of the above-named Act as to the manner of settlement of any question incidental to or arising out of the interpretation of the said agreement: Now, we, the parties to the said agreement, further agree that the said matters shall be referred to the Conciliation Commissioner for the Otago and Southland Industrial District for interpretation.
