

(5356.) OTAGO AND SOUTHLAND INDUSTRIAL DISTRICT TRAWLER  
EMPLOYEES.—ORDER AMENDING AWARD.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Otago and Southland Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908, and its amendments; and in the matter of the War Legislation and Statute Law Amendment Act, 1918; and in the matter of the Otago and Southland Industrial District Trawler Employees' award dated the 22nd day of September, 1917, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. xviii, p. 732.

UPON reading the application of the Dunedin Trawlers' Industrial Union of Workers filed herein on the 14th day of June, 1919, and upon hearing the duly appointed representatives of the said union and of the employers parties to the said award, this Court, having regard to all the relevant considerations and being of opinion that it is just and equitable to amend the said award, doth hereby order that the said award shall be amended in manner following, that is to say—

1. The following additional subclause shall be added to clause 2 of the said award:—

“(h.) In addition to the minimum rates prescribed by subclauses (a), (b), and (c) hereof there shall be paid to the workers

therein mentioned a bonus of 5s. per week unless and until the Court shall otherwise order.”

2. This order shall operate and take effect from the 1st day of September, 1919.
