

(5364.) DUNEDIN (TWENTY-MILES RADIUS) PAINTERS AND DECORATORS.—ORDER ADDING PARTY TO AWARD.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Otago and Southland Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908, and its amendments; and in the matter of an award dated the 28th day of November, 1918, made in an industrial dispute between the Dunedin Painters' Industrial Union of Workers and the Dunedin Master Painters' Industrial Union of Employers and others.
