

(5118.) WESTFIELD CHEMICAL-MANURE WORKERS.—ORDER
INCREASING WAR BONUS.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Northern Industrial District. — In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908, and its amendments; and in the matter of an industrial agreement dated the 21st day of December, 1917, made between the Westfield Chemical-manure Workers' Industrial Union of Workers of the first part, and Kempthorne,

Prosser and Co. New Zealand Drug Company (Limited) of the other part.

UPON reading the application of the party to the said agreement of the first part, and after hearing the representative of the said party and the representative of the other party to the said agreement, this Court, in pursuance of the provision in that behalf contained in clause 2, subclause (e), of the said industrial agreement and of every other power in that behalf enabling it, doth hereby determine that the war bonus provided by subclause (d) of said clause 2 shall be and it is hereby increased to 15 per cent. as from the 31st day of March, 1919.
