(5385.) NORTHERN DISTRICT (EXCEPT POVERTY BAY) BEAMSMEN.—
ORDER AMENDING AWARD.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Northern Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908, and its amendments; and in the matter of the War Legislation and Statute Law Amendment Act, 1918; and in the matter of the Northern District (except Poverty Bay) Beamsmen's award dated the 23rd day of September, 1918, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. xix, p. 900.

Upon reading the application of the Auckland Beamsmen's Industrial Union of Workers filed herein on the 16th day of April, 1919, and upon hearing the duly appointed representatives of the said union and of the employers parties to the said award, this Court, having regard to all the relevant considerations and being of opinion that it is just and equitable to amend the said award, doth hereby order that the said award shall be amended in manner following, that is to say—

1. Subclauses (e) and (f) of clause 2 of the said award shall be

deleted, and the following provisions substituted therefor: -

"(e.) In addition to the minimum rates prescribed in subclauses (a) and (b) of this clause there shall be paid to the workers therein mentioned a bonus of 3d. per hour unless and until the Court shall otherwise order."

This order shall operate and take effect from the 22nd day of September, 1919.
