

(5395.) CANTERBURY INDUSTRIAL DISTRICT TAILORS AND  
TAILORESSES.—ORDER AMENDING AWARD.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Canterbury Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908, and its amendments; and in the matter of the War Legislation and Statute Law Amendment Act, 1918; and in the matter of the Canterbury Industrial District Tailors and Tailoresses' award dated the 15th day of December, 1917, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. xviii, p. 1326.

UPON reading the application of the Christchurch Tailoring Trade Industrial Union of Workers filed herein on the 7th day of August, 1919, and upon hearing the duly appointed representatives of the said union and of the employers parties to the said award and with the consent of the said employers, this Court, having regard to all the relevant considerations and being of opinion that it is just and equitable to amend the said award, doth hereby order that the said award shall be amended in manner following, that is to say—

1. Subclause (*e*) of clause 2 of the said award shall be deleted, and the following provisions substituted therefor:—

“(*e*.) With regard to pieceworkers, the time statement recorded in Vol. xviii of the Book of Awards, at p. 122 of the Supplement

to the said volume, shall be deemed to be incorporated with and to form part of this award, and shall be binding on all parties to this award. The said time statement shall for the purposes of this award be calculated at the rate of 1s. 2d. per hour for males and 10d. per hour for females.”

2. This order shall operate and take effect from the 15th day of September, 1919.
