

(5397.) CANTERBURY BUTCHERS.—ORDER AMENDING AWARD.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Canterbury Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908, and its amendments; and in the matter of the War Legislation and Statute Law Amendment Act, 1918; and in the matter of the Canterbury Butchers' award dated the 30th day of July, 1918, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. xix, p. 664.

UPON reading the application of the Christchurch Operative Butchers' Industrial Union of Workers filed herein on the 8th day of August, 1919, and upon hearing the duly appointed representatives of the said union and of the employers parties to the said award, this Court, having regard to all the relevant considerations and being of opinion that it is just and equitable to amend the said award, doth hereby order that the said award shall be amended in manner following, that is to say—

1. Subclause (c) of clause 2 of the said award shall be deleted, and the following provisions substituted therefor:—

“(c.) In addition to the wages prescribed in clauses 2 and 3 of this award all such workers shall receive a bonus of 20 per cent.”

2. The following additional subclause shall be added to clause 4 of the said award:—

“(d.) In addition to the rates prescribed in subclause (a) of this clause there shall be paid to such boys and youths a bonus of 10 per cent. on the said rates.”

3. Subclause (d) of clause 12 of the said award shall be deleted, and the following provisions substituted therefor:—

“(d.) In addition to the wages prescribed in subclauses (a) and (b) of this clause there shall be paid to such workers a bonus of 20 per cent. upon the said rates.”

4. This award shall operate and take effect as from the 1st day of July, 1919.
